REGINA-MSP PROJECT

The project “Regions to boost National Maritime Spatial Planning” aims at improving the participation of Regions as well as local authorities and stakeholders in the development and implementation of National maritime spatial planning.

REGINA-MSP combines a general assay and discussion at European level with an **analysis on regional case studies chosen in 5 countries.**



Task 3.1 aims at **analysing coastal and marine strategies and plans already in place**, focusing on those (both crosscutting and sectoral) relevant for maritime spatial planning through a series of workshops. 30 people attended the first workshop meeting on the topic of “Regional data and geoportal for MSP needs”, held by the Shom (the French Hydrographic and Oceanographic Service).

At first, the meeting was the opportunity to recall the objectives of MSP and of the REGINA-MSP project as well as to quickly provide an outlook of Shom activities. The second part of the meeting was focused on the guest country Greece with presentations of their geoportals (THAL-CHOR 2, HER-SEA), an example of tool use in the Cyclade for MSP and a presentation on **how Greece adapts its national geodata to regional MSP** by partners from Panteion University, University of Aegean and Aristotle University of Thessaloniki.
